Guidelines & Participation Rules



The 2010 Miss & Little Miss Juneteenth Pageant are limited to 10 contestants in each category. If more than enough contestants enter Juneteenth Beauty Pageant there will be four different categories. Jr. Princess – Ages 4-6, Princess 7-10, Little Miss 11-13, Miss 14-17 (18 of age are accepted if attending High School).

1. *Contestants are required to attend all meetings and rehearsals. Rehearsal time is very limited and contestants must be on time. Rehearsals are CLOSED to anyone not participating in the pageant. If a contestant cannot attend, it is very imperative that the contestant or parent/guardian notify the Juneteenth Pageant Coordinators: Candise Moore or LaDonna Moore at least 24hours before meeting or rehearsals.
Dates and Times for meetings, rehearsals and additional activities will be given at first initial meeting.*
2. *Contestants must be willing to participate in all fundraising activities for the benefit Miss and Little Miss Juneteenth Pageant. (Selling raffle tickets and securing advertisements for pageant program book are part of the fundraising duties....etc).*
3. *Contestants and their parent(s)/guardian must abide by the rules and regulations set by G.E.A.Y.A. - Juneteenth Committee at all times. The G.E.A.Y.A. - Juneteenth Committee reserves the right to add or modify any rules, as it deems necessary.*
4. *G.E.A.Y.A. - Juneteenth Committee has the right to dismiss any contestant, if they are found to be: uncooperative, disruptive, excessive tardiness, inattentive (3), or if there is any misconduct, being disrespectful to others or non-observance of the rules.*
5. *Contestants and their parent(s)/guardian hereby authorizes the G.E.A.Y.A. - Juneteenth Committee to use their name(s), including any stage name(s),image(s), film, digital, video or other forms for: informational, promotional, broadcasting or other purposes, such as; in any print, audio, video, online, or electronic media or other formats, involving any G.E.A.Y.A. - Juneteenth activity or for any subsequent events.*
6. *G.E.A.Y.A. - Juneteenth Committee will determine scoring system procedures. The "Title" of Miss Juneteenth and Little Miss Juneteenth and her Court will be decided upon and awarded by a panel of selective judges according to the rules and regulations set forth by the G.E.A.Y.A. - Juneteenth Pageant Committee, and the judging results will be final.*
7. *Be of good moral character.*
8. *No gum chewing is allowed during meetings, rehearsals or Miss/Little Miss Juneteenth pageant.*
9. *G.E.A.Y.A. AND THE JUNETEENTH COMMITTEE takes every precaution to ensure the safety of everyone during these events, please use safety at all times. Please keep personal items locked up at all times. G.E.A.Y.A. – Juneteenth Committee will not be liable for any accidents or lost, stolen or damaged items during meetings, rehearsals, fundraising, Miss and Little Miss Juneteenth Pageant and/or any other function set by the committee.*
